In 2021 we successfully made the Inspiring
Futures Academy international by making it
available to women & girls in **Ireland**.

We work to achieve common goals with other **UK** organisations like the Home Office and the

Department of Work and Pensions, social

services and the education sector, and more

In **South-Africa** we have built a fully equipped technology classroom with learning curriculum and early childhood learning centre, creating a safe a secure centre for education and wellbeing.

We have invested in a variety of projects in **Kenya** such as self-sustaining school business farms and water sanitation. This has led to job creation, improved health and nutrition, and school participation for women and girls.

Our Goals

We believe that with your support, we can achieve our goals for 2023-4. There are several ways in which you can be an integral part of our mission. We would appreciate it if you could take some time to consider the different ways in which you can support us. Thank you for your consideration.



Fundraising

Our agile structure and operating model ensure maximum efficiency and quality of service delivery. This means our cost to serve is around £185 per beneficiary. Our aim is to raise £135k by the end of 2023 and £335k by the end of 2024 to support the national and international growth and impact of the ILF.

Increase Resources: Grow

Investing in resources – recruitment of core staff including certification of trainers to deliver safe, world-class services and support in the UK and internationally.

Target: £77k in 2023; £245k in 2024

Digital Technologies: Build

Investing in digital – provision of software and licenses that protect and manage our data, and provide women and girls access to inspirational development, vital resources and career content anytime, anywhere.

Target: £16k in 2023; £30k in 2024

03

International Development: Develop

Investment in vital projects for the health, education, and employment for women and girls in under-developed communities, ensuring participation in our IFA community.

Target: £30k in 2023; £45k in 2024

Safeguarding

Investing in core operations – ensuring our governance, audits and safeguarding practices are embedded and vital CRM including communications with and management of partners, volunteers and beneficiaries.

Target: £12k in 2023; £14.5k in 2024.



We are open to any books, ranging from self-help to business and education. We are are particularly interested in audiobook subscriptions for our beneficiaries in international locations.




VENUE HIRE

We offer a mentorship programme wherein women and girls can connect with an inspiring mentor who can provide both professional and personal guidance.

Mentoring is a one-to-one nonjudgemental relationship where mentors give their time to support their mentees to achieve their ambitions. Mentors draw on their own experience to provide best possible insight.

What is involved?

- Mentors help their mentee to build awareness of their aspirations and develop the skills and behaviours to achieve these aspirations.
- Mentors assist mentees in writing and editing their CV and prepare for further education, job applications and interviews.
- Mentoring sessions occur at least monthly and email communication is encouraged fortnightly.



- **Job Opportunities**: We can facilitate the promotion of job opportunities to the disadvantaged women we serve. This is worthwhile as it enables you to support underrepresented groups, promote diversity and inclusion in the workplace, and tap into a wider range of skills and experiences. Additionally, it provides women and girls with valuable employment opportunities that may not have been available to them otherwise, helping to create a more equitable and empowered society.


